- Acting and engaging as representatives in relation to any ad hoc local community issues for residents.
- Continue to focus on the parking issue on the estate aiming to get an acceptable solution in place for all parties which should complement the potential introduction of a new bus route
- Continue to ensure that the land reserved for a community facility is developed in line with residents wants and needs for the area and explore ways in which Radford Park Residents Association can work in partnership with organisations as part of the establishment of such a facility
- Acting and engaging as representatives in relation to any ad hoc local community issues for residents.
